



### **Program Summary**

Pi Plus Tutors is recognized by the WA Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction as a state-wide provider of Supplemental Educational Services (SES) to qualifying students who attend eligible schools in the state of Washington. A student's eligibility is determined on his/her free or reduced lunch status as well as enrollment in a school that has been classified as "needing improvement" for at least three consecutive years, as based on the annual MSP test. Our program provides one-on-one or small group instruction, free of charge for low-income families in diverse socioeconomic communities. Our tutors are dedicated members of the community, typically certified teachers or passionate business professionals specializing in the area in which they tutor.

There are countless tutoring organizations across the state offering this service, but there are many areas where we set ourselves apart.
