King County, WA is part of the Seattle-Bellevue, WA HUD Metro FMR Area, which consists of the following counties: King County, WA; and Snohomish County, WA. All information here applies to the entirety of the Seattle-Bellevue, WA HUD Metro FMR Area.

The FY 2024 Fair Market Rents for Seattle-Bellevue, WA HUD Metro FMR Area are based on the results of a local rent survey conducted in October 2022.

The locally conducted survey is more current than the available ACS data. Therefore HUD calculates the locally based survey 2-bedroom FMR using the following steps:

1. The local survey is adjusted to annual 2022 dollars by multiplying the survey rent value for 2022 by the annual CPI-based Gross Rent value for 2022 divided by the CPI-based Gross Rent value for October 2022. This calculation is:

2. The CPI adjusted survey value of \$2,340 is trended forward to the mid-point of FY2024 using the Seattle-Tacoma-Bellevue, WA trend factor of 1.1305. This calculation is:
