Kitsap County, WA is part of the Bremerton-Silverdale, WA MSA, which consists of the following counties: Kitsap County, WA. All information here applies to the entirety of the Bremerton-Silverdale, WA MSA.

The FY 2024 Fair Market Rents for Bremerton-Silverdale, WA MSA are based on the results of a local rent survey conducted in November 2021.

The locally conducted survey is more current than the available ACS data. Therefore HUD calculates the locally based survey 2-bedroom FMR using the following steps:

1. The local survey is adjusted to annual 2021 dollars by multiplying the survey rent value for 2021 by the annual CPI-based Gross Rent value for 2021 divided by the CPI-based Gross Rent value for November 2021. This calculation is:

2. The annually adjusted survey value of \$1,709 is augmented by the growth in gross rents from the *West Census region* measured between 2021 and 2022. This calculation is:

3. The CPI adjusted survey value of \$1,841 is trended forward to the mid-point of FY2024 using the *West Census region* trend factor of 1.1128. This calculation is:
