Low Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP)

APPLICABLE LEGISLATION, STATUTE, REGULATIONS

- 1. The administration of this program is authorized under Section 533 Title V of Division H of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, Public Law No: 116-260. Consistent with legislative instructions, program requirements use existing processes, procedures, and policies currently in place to help low-income households. OCS has closely modeled the Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program's (LIHWAP) terms and conditions on assurances and requirements outlined in the Low-Income Household Energy Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C. 8621 et seq.
- 2. The Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for HHS Awards is located under <u>45 CFR Part 75</u>. In accordance with 45 CFR 75.101 applicability, this program must comply with 45 CFR Part 75 in its entirety. No exceptions have been identified.
- 3. Additional applicable regulations and requirements can be found in the <u>General Terms and Conditions</u> for Mandatory: Formula, Block and Entitlement Grants.

Purpose:

This grant shall be used as part of an overall emergency effort to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus, with the public health focus of ensuring that Low Income households have access to safe and clean drinking water and wastewater services.

Funds will be used to help low-income households—particularly those with the lowest incomes—that pay a high proportion of household income for drinking water and wastewater services

Eligibility

Must have an enrolled Samish Citizen living in the household

Priority will be given to household in which one individual who is 60 years of age older, include a household member with a disability or include a young children under the age of five (5).

Must live in Ten (10) County service area: Clallam, Island, Jefferson, King, Kitsap, Pierce, San Juan, Skagit, Snohomish, and Whatcom.

Household Income Documentation:

- 1. A Household receiving one of the following resources will be automatically enrolled in the LIHWAP:
 - a. Social Security Benefits
 - b. Supplemental Security Income.
 - c. Food Stamps
 - d. Veterans' and Survivors' Pension Improvement Act of 1978
 - e. Households receiving payments under the Low-Income Home Emergency Assistance Program (LIHEAP)
- 2. Households with incomes that do not exceed 60 percent of the State Median income.
- 3. The tribe may give priority to those households with the highest home water costs or needs in relation to household income.
- 4. Families unable to provide documented proof of income, due to COVID-19, can complete a self- declaration of income until such time as documented proof of income can be obtained.

Assistance Provided:

- 1. Assistance to households will be accomplished by providing funds to vendors of public water systems or treatment works to reduce arrears of and rates charged to such households for such services.
- 2. The amount of assistance to each household will be based on a Matrix, approved by Tribal Council.
- 3. For all payments to vendors on behalf of individual households, the following will occur:
 - a. Notify the vendor and the participating household the amount of assistance that has been paid on their behalf.
 - b. Ensure that the vendor will charge the eligible household, in the normal billing process, the difference between the actual amount due and the amount of the payment made by the LIHWAP grant.
 - c. Ensure that any agreement made between Samish Indian Nation and the Vendor will contain provisions to ensure that no household receiving assistance will be treated adversely because of such assistance.
 - d. Ensure that the vendor provides written reconciliation and confirmation on a regular basis that benefits have been credited appropriately to households and their services have been restored on a timely basis or disconnection status has been removed if applicable.
 - e. The amount of any home water assistance benefits provided under this program for the benefit of an eligible household shall not be considered income or resources of such household (or any member thereof) for any purpose under any State, Territorial, or Tribal law, including any law relating to taxation, public assistance, or welfare programs.
 - f. Samish Indian Nation, through its appeal process, will provide an opportunity for a fair administrative hearing to individuals whose claims for assistance

under a LIHWAP plan are denied or are not acted upon with reasonable promptness. Policy 13.207

Low-Income Home Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP) Effective October 1, 2022, through September 31, 2023

Minimum Benefit is 85% - Maximum Benefit is 100%

Minimum Dollar Amount: \$25.00 – Maximum Amount \$1500.00 Per Household Rural Areas: Minimum Dollar Amount: \$25.00 -Maximum Amount \$2000.00 Per Household

Eligibility is based upon the gross income guidelines listed below. Benefit amount can change based on funding.
